Cheesy Garlic Bread (Cajun style!)

½ cup butter or margarine
¼ cup mayonnaise
1 Tablespoon minced garlic
1 teaspoon SMOKED PAPRIKA
¼ teaspoon onion powder
¼ teaspoon garlic powder
Course black pepper
Kosher salt
¼ cup (or more if you like) Parmesan cheese
¼ cup (or more if you like) Mozzarella cheese
Can add chopped fresh parsley

Must use SMOKED PAPRIKA .. can be doubled, tripled. Spread on bread of choice and toast. Will keep in refrigerator for a long time.
